

MATTHIAS PAINTER STONEY CREEK 1802

IMAGES OF WILL & DEED

- Mathias Bender/Painter, heir at Law of John Painter, decd.
 - Will
 - Deeds to his sons

Deeds that implement above will:

Grantor in each case is "Matthias Painter, eldest son and heir at law of John Painter decd."

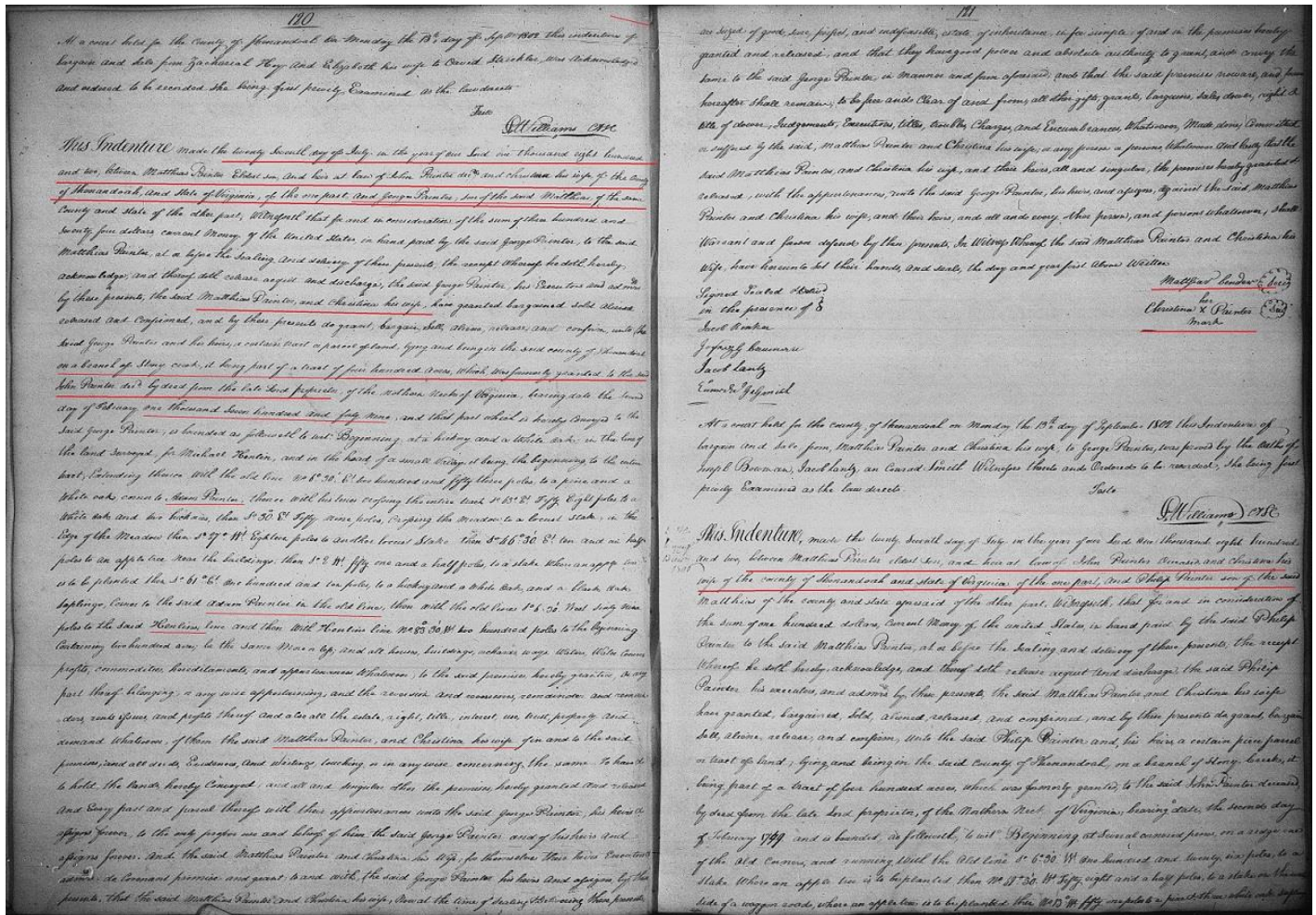
Notice that Matthias uses the surname "Bender" in the will but "Painter" in the deeds.

Each deed is granted to a specific son of Matthias and each deed is to a specific part of the land as specified in the above will.

Only one such deed is shown here as an example for each of the others.

son, George Painter: Shenandoah Co. Deed Bk. N , p. 120 (27 Jun 1802)

The others are similar



See the other deeds—Shenandoah County Deed Book N, dated 27 June 1802.

- **To son George 200 ac with big stone house (p. 120)**
- **To son Phillip Painter 156 ac where he lives (p. 121)**
- **To son John Painter 276 ac. where he lives (p 123)**
- **To son Adam Painter 140 ac middle part of plantation and small stone house (p. 124)**
